Mobile Phone Usage in School

The safety and wellbeing of our children is always our priority. We recognise that some families may wish for their child to bring a mobile phone into school—for example, for travel to and from school. However, we strongly recommend that children do not bring mobile phones into school wherever possible.

For those children who do bring a phone, our policy is clear:

- Phones must be handed in at the school office before entering the playground at the beginning of the day.
- Phones can then be collected from the office once children have left the playground at the end of the day.

This ensures that phones are kept securely during the school day, reducing the risk of loss, distraction, or inappropriate use.

We kindly ask for your support in reminding your child about this routine. Together, we can keep learning distraction-free and maintain a positive environment where everyone can thrive. Thank you for your continued cooperation.

Trading Tuesdays and Thursdays

Trading Tuesdays and Thursdays will return later in the year. For now, all trading items should stay at home so we can focus on rebuilding routines and expectations in school.
