Improving Attendance













We know that great attendance is about more than being in school — it's about building strong friendships, keeping the rhythm of learning, and feeling part of our community every day together. We are really pleased that attendance so far this year stands at 95.4% compared with 93.8% at the same point last year. This steady improvement is already making a real difference to the learning taking place. Every day really does count, and while 95% is a good foundation, aiming for 98% means fewer missed opportunities and more chances for each child to flourish across their four years with us. To put it in perspective, an 85% attendance rate over 4 years is more than half a school year missed — a powerful reminder of why everyday matters.
