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



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Dyslexia Screenings

Did you find learning challenging at school? Has your child's teacher talked to you about support for your child's reading/writing, or about carrying out a Dyslexia screening test and you've thought, "I wonder if I'm dyslexic?"

Dyslexia Cornwall are a charity, who have just started offering a completely free Dyslexia Screening service to adults, which comes with supportive mentoring sessions to understand your barriers to learning. They will help teach you strategies to overcome any challenges and help improve your confidence as a reader/writer.
