Planning skills, area, shape, money and time will be consolidated in this project.</p>	<p>Non-Fiction: The Origin of Species</p> <p>Recount of Bristol trip</p> <p>Narrative: Hansel and Gretel</p>	<p>Short texts, fiction and non-fiction, some linked to our project with a VIPERS focus (vocabulary, inference, prediction, evaluation, retrieval, summary)</p>	<p>This project teaches children about Africa past and present and the development of the slave trade. It also explores Britain's role in the transatlantic slave trade, the causes and consequences of the European colonisation of Africa and the worldwide communities that make up the African diaspora.</p>	<p>Light-The topic introduces the concept of light travelling in straight lines. It starts by looking at beams of light and how light travels to enable children to understand how we see things. This understanding is then applied to the production of shadows and starts to look at how light is reflected.</p>	<p>The children develop their understanding of their feelings, learn more about how to stay safe online, develop their understanding of how their bodies change through puberty, also learning about how babies are conceived through sexual intercourse and will discuss stereotypes.</p> <p>Should you have any questions relating to the content of these lessons, then please speak with your child's class teacher.</p>
