Each day your child will need to access Google Classrooms where there will be a folder of daily lessons and activities (maths, reading, writing and spelling). Once the activities are completed, please upload so that the teacher can assess the work and use this to plan for further learning. These lessons will be available for a week and then removed ready for the next weeks learning.

Lots of the lessons will be supported by video clips. From the feedback so far, parents are saying that these are easier to use.

There will also be an enrichment folder which will have weekly science lessons as well as other projects including art., PE, DT, RE and fun stuff etc. These activities are there for you to choose from to suit your child's interests or as a motivator to complete the daily lessons. They are not compulsory. Teachers will assess work from this folder once a week.
