Home learning

Free School Meal Vouchers

Vouchers for weeks beginning 4th January and 11th January, have been backdated and sent to you via Wonde, from the Aspire Admin Team. From this week, week commencing 18th January, the school will be issuing the FSM vouchers via Eden Red. The value of the voucher depends on the number of days your child has been offered a meal in school (as some children are in some of the days) and this is having to be calculated each week.

We will therefore only be able to order the vouchers on a Friday. This means your voucher for week beginning 18th January should be with you on Monday 25th January, and effectively you will always be a week in arrears.

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Unfortunately we did not receive a response from every family confirming their email address so if you do not receive your voucher, this could be that we do not have the correct email address for you.

As with anything IT based – we hope that the issuing of vouchers goes smoothly and you receive your vouchers promptly. However, we ask for your patience in case there is a delay.

Lateral Flow Testing

As you may be aware the government has now begun to roll out the next phase of their COVID testing plan which includes all staff working in primary and nursery education being offered the opportunity to take part in regular asymptomatic testing.
