Dear Parents/Carers,

This has been a very difficult week for our school as we have had lots of staff absence due to a variety of reasons - not all Covid related. Unfortunately, teaching supply agencies are also under lots of pressure as all schools are placing unprecedented demands upon them. They simply haven't got the capacity needed and are often cancelling on us at the last minute. We are again dealing with the outcomes of new Covid guidance and trying to navigate an unknown. I am very disappointed with having to close two of our classes due to insufficient staffing numbers, but this was absolutely the right decision under the circumstances. Being a leader in education in the current climate is testing everyone's resilience and until we walk in another's shoes, we can never really understand what their experiences are. I am very sorry that parents/carers are again being inconvenienced and life for some is being made all that bit harder, but please remember lots of our staff are parents too and are experiencing similar difficulties. Nikki has done a great job in the office and if you do have any questions, please remember she can only answer with what she knows and is able to legally share. These are strenuous times for us all.

The staff in school have worked incredibly hard and gone over and above to keep the rest of the school buzzing with learning and safe. We have so far managed to keep breakfast club and after school club running thanks to staff volunteering. Without their dedication to our school community, the situation would be far worse. There will no doubt be more disappointments, if we have to postpone planned events, but in this new ever-changing world of Covid nothing is for certain.

Since September we have maintained all the Covid measures of regular handwashing, ventilation, outdoor learning where possible, assemblies remotely or outside (e.g. singing assemblies) and have encouraged parents/carers to get PCR tests when any child has presented with symptoms – new and old versions and wear masks when on site. We will continue to follow the guidance from Public Health.

On a more positive note, please take a look at the latest edition of The Splash when this is published, as this will demonstrate all we have been able to offer your children so far this term.

I stay hopeful for more settled times to come.
