Healthy lunches

We are really keen to encourage healthy lunches for all our children; government advice suggests using the "Eatwell" plate below as a guide to provide a healthy, balanced diet to support your child's health and development.

We have noticed recently, more and more children are being given very high sugar, high fat food items in the lunch boxwe will be monitoring this and might contact you to offer support to make some changes.



It is recommended that children between 5 and 10 years old should have no more than 20-25 grams per day.
