Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back everyone!

I have been so impressed with how everyone returned to school on Wednesday. Our Year 3's have settled in wonderfully and there is a calm and purposeful feeling around school.

Please may we remind you of the school start and end times:

We will open the gates from **8.40am** with children going straight into classrooms. School will **start at 8.50am** so we are trying to maintain some sort of staggered start to support parents with drop off and parking. School will finish at **3.10pm** for all pupils and the **two side gates** will remain in use. We are opening the gate nearest the infants at 3pm for parents/carers to stand in the small playground and wait to collect their child. I apologise for the crowds on Wednesday, hopefully things have improved, and I will continue to monitor the situation.

Pupils in **Wanson**, **Northcott**, and **Sandymouth** enter and exit via the gate nearest the large **car park and large playground**.

Pupils in **Millook**, **Crooklets**, **Duckpool**, **Summerleaze**, **Crackington** and **Widemouth**, will enter via the **side gate nearest to the infants**.
