Last day of term Thursday 22nd July. We have an inset day on Friday 23rd July.

This week:

Next week:

- Covid-19 restrictions: Following official guidance from Aspire we will be maintaining our bubbles, regular handwashing routines, ventilating rooms and maintaining social distancing for the last week of term despite the end of lockdown. Following increasing positive cases in Bude and the whole of Cornwall, we feel this will give our staff and pupils be best chance of a healthy start to the summer holiday. 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Next term:

- The first day of the new term is **Wednesday 8**th **September**.
- School start times: We will open the gates from 8.40am with children going straight into classrooms. School will start at 8.50am so we are trying to maintain some sort of staggered start to support parents with drop off and parking. School will finish at 3.10pm for all pupils and the two side gates will remain in use.

Pupils in **Wanson**, **Northcott**, and **Sandymouth** enter and exit via the gate nearest the large **car park and large playground**.

Pupils in **Millook**, **Crooklets**, **Duckpool**, **Summerleaze**, **Crackington** and **Widemouth**, will enter via the **side gate nearest to the infants**.

- Parking: Please respectfully only use the disabled bays for a quick drop and go. Parking in these means those who have a disability cannot use the space. Please also respect the zebra crossing markings. I am in conversation with Aspire premises regarding reviewing and refreshing the markings. Thank you all for not parking on the double yellow lines; this has really improved the flow of traffic and is better/safer for everyone including other road users.
- **PE:** Please come to school in your PE kits on PE days. This is a Covid change we are going to keep.





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- Attendance will be a whole-school priority. Please ensure that your child arrives at school in good time and ready to learn.
- In September, should you be happy for your child to walk home, or leave school accompanied, please can you telephone the office so we can amend the consent section on their records.
- Mrs Smeeth will be working for The Aspire Finance team 3 days a week from September, but she will remain in school on Thursdays and Fridays. We wish her well with her new venture.
- Mrs Whelan will be returning after the summer to provide leadership cover. This
 will help release teachers so they can carry out strategic subject leadership
 actions. We also welcome Mrs Stevenson who will be supporting in Northcott
 for the autumn term.
