Lateness

We have noticed a high number of late arrivals in the morning which we are closely monitoring.

The children who are recorded as consistently late will be discussed with our Education Welfare Officer next term.

Bude Primary Academy are committed to maximising the education of all their pupils and aim to work with parents to ensure this can be achieved. Lateness to school disrupts learning and teaching time and therefore parents are asked to ensure that their children attend school on time.

Do you know?

Being late for school reduces learning time.

If your child is **5 minutes late** every day, they will miss **three days** of learning each vear.

If your child is **15 minutes late** every day, they will miss **2 weeks** of learning each year.

Please consider as well:

how does the child feel walking into class after everyone else? are they expecting a school dinner? - how will this be ordered if they are late?
