<u>Parents' evenings – Tuesday 9th and Wednesday 10th November</u> - Please book your consultation via the Arbor app if you have not done so already. Please contact the office if you cannot login to the Arbor app.

There are 10-minute slots for the parents' evening. These are being offered as face-to-face appointments in your child's classroom; however, if you would prefer a phone call this can be done by booking a time slot on the App or in agreement with the class teacher for a different day. If you book a slot on the Arbor App and are not at school for your time, then the class teacher will know you want a phone call and will give you a call at that time. If you do come to school, we are asking that you please:

- Do a lateral flow test and ensure it is negative
- Wear a face covering unless you are exempt
- Hand sanitise on arrival
- Windows will be open for ventilation
- The meeting will be held at a social distance
- Adults only if possible
- Arrive at your time and wait outside on the patio area, enter via the main gate
- Keep to your time (we know 10 minutes is not long and if you do require a longer meeting then please arrange for another time)
